## **PLAY FOR VEGAS 2022 AND HAWAII VACATION**

Destination is treated as an extended spring session – Players need 8 matches on their team roster to be eligible for playoffs (in April) and post session play – Captains are eligible for L&O Team Captains Tournament – All players are eligible for L&O 8-Ball Doubles qualifier, fun tournaments, and are invited to the Annual Christmas Party!



# NEW PLAYOFF & WILDCARD STRUCTURE

- Not all teams will advance to the Hawaii Championship
- We will have 2 separate playoffs, one to advance teams to the Spring Tri-Annual and another to advance teams to the Hawaii LTC (HLTC)
- No more 2<sup>nd</sup> place or 3<sup>rd</sup> place cruise – if we get 20+ teams a cash payout will be awarded.
- Hawaii LTC (HLTC) will be a Modified Single Elimination over 2 days instead of a Single elimination over 2 days (yay)

Playoff for Spring Tri-Annual on individual division size. Remember a bye does not count as a team. Wildcard will be pulled at the Captains Meeting – if your team is not present a proxy will be assigned. Teams who lose to a wildcard in playoff advance to Best of the Rest (BOTR) just like other Spring divisions.

<b>12 - 16 Teams:</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place high points finishers automatically advance to Tri-Annuals <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Playoff match: 4<sup>th</sup> place vs Wild Card, winner advances to Tri-Annuals</li> <li>• Loser of Playoffs advances to Best of the Rest</li> </ul>
<b>6 - 11 Teams:</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> place high points finisher automatically advances to Tri-Annuals <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Playoff match: 3<sup>rd</sup> place vs. Wild Card, winner advances to Tri-Annuals</li> <li>• Loser of Playoffs advances to Best of the Rest</li> </ul>

Playoffs for Hawaii LTC will pull standings between all destination divisions. We will post the Destination Big Dawg Report each week to show where your team stacks up against the rest. Wildcard will be pulled at the Captains Meeting – if your team is not present a proxy will be assigned.

<b>16 - 19 Total Destination Teams:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> place high points finishers advance to Hawaii LTC.</li> <li>• 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> place finisher advance to playoffs</li> <li>• 9<sup>th</sup> – Last-place teams participate in a wildcard, 4 teams’ advance.</li> <li>• The playoff is 1 round; teams will be matched based on session-ending points. The winner of the playoff match will advance to the Hawaii LTC.</li> </ul>
<b>20 - 24 Teams:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> place high points finishers advance to Hawaii LTC.</li> <li>• 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, and 10<sup>th</sup> place finisher advance to playoffs</li> <li>• 11<sup>th</sup> – Last-place teams participate in a wildcard, 5 teams’ advance.</li> <li>• The playoff is 1 round; teams will be matched based on session-ending points. The winner of the playoff match will advance to the Hawaii LTC.</li> </ul>
